## Fundraising, Genevieve Geib, Kim Delahanty

- WOT ticket sales were \$155.
- Belk \$1,400 total sales/\$745 Opt-out. A special thanks to Dawn Booth for organizing the Belk sale. She also sold tickets the morning of the sale, adding an additional \$200 to the band's revenue.
- Spirit Night is at Firehouse Subs on Thursday, 11/10, from 4-9. The school will receive 10% of all sales during that time. A holiday meal before the holiday band concert is being explored.
